

CRoW - Payments for Tasks

Econet/CRoW does **not** charge for tasks, however we are happy to accept donations and would encourage organisations for whom we work to donate if they have funding available.

Currently we ask £60 for a task.

Normally the money raised by this means covers the cost of refreshments and transport expenses relating to CRoW tasks, with a surplus going to help pay for Econet's other costs, e.g. insurance, tools, publicity, etc..

Notes:

- Reading Borough Council do not normally make payments unless the work is to help deliver a project for which they are receiving external funding. However, it should be remembered that they do provide us with tool storage.
- West Berkshire Council have made payments for tasks on their sites and BBOWT has continued to do so for work on the West Berkshire Council sites now managed by them. BBOWT has indicated they would consider making payments for tasks on their own reserves.
- The John Simmonds Trust has made payments for tasks at Rushall Farm unless these have been for our benefit, e.g. for hedgelaying materials or bean poles.
- The National Trust has not made us payments, however the amount of work we have done for them in recent years has been limited and at times when it is difficult to find work elsewhere.
- Other sites where we have received payment include Lavell's Lake and the Wolf Trust.
